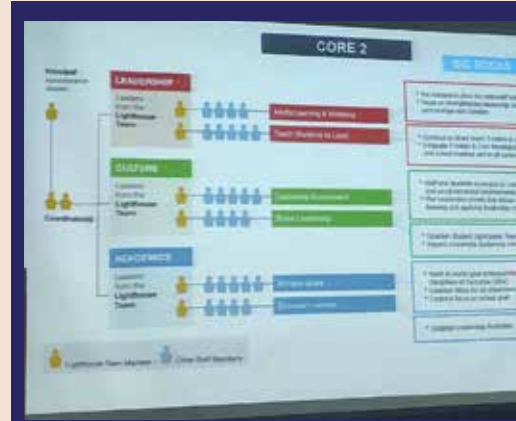
CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION

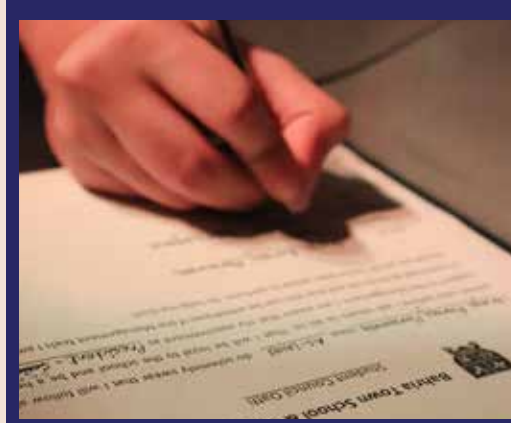
