INTRODUCTION

Children are innately interested in learning about the world around them as they have an inquisitive nature. BTSC Preschool, comprising of Playgroup, Nursery, Kindergarten and Prep classes, is well-equipped to cater the curiosity of the young minds with state-of –the-art classrooms and a well-trained and qualified staff.

Our preschoolers learn through handson activities and games. Our classes have a wide range of manipulating toys, puzzles and learning centers to develop cognitive skills in children. The teachers use songs, stories and dramatic plays to build on their previous knowledge and to create a deeper understanding of the world around them. They are encouraged to observe, ask questions and find answers through logic, exploration, experimentation, and conversation.

OUR CURRICULUM & PROGRAM









Behavior Management is a major component of the BTSC Preschool agenda. Through daily classroom interactions, we teach our students moral values like honesty, patience, respect for others, forgiveness, compassion, responsibility, discipline and empathy. These values are reinforced daily during the morning meeting (Circle Time) as the WBT (Whole Brain Teaching) rules.

BTSC Preschool curriculum revolves around literacy, numeracy and the world around us. We start with the Pre-Math and preliteracy skills. Children are taught recognition of numbers and letters (English and Urdu alphabets) through songs and drills. We build on that and teach them to read and solve basic Math problems like addition and subtraction. Our teacher-students ratio is kept low to ensure that each child gets individual attention in class.

BTSC Preschool is just not about achieving academic success; we enable our students to gain confidence as capable, responsible and independent learners.

We do not have formal assessments for Preschoolers. We have designed learning outcomes for each class which form the basis for continuous assessments of the children. They are observed daily in class and assessed by conducting several oral and written assessments.

By providing an environment that is conducive to learning, BTSC Preschool enables children to develop the fundamental capacities that they need to be happy, fulfilled and prepared for a more formal learning process, at Junior level. We also celebrate Theme Days related to what the children are learning in their classes. We use activities like Show and Tell so the children can share their knowledge and develop public-speaking skills.



PRIMARY SCHOOL

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Students of Junior School, which comprises of Grade I till V, are trained to meet real-life challenges by enhancing their understanding of the world through dealing with skills pertaining to Math, Science, Languages, Humanities, Social Studies and ICT in order to prepare them for the advanced competence level at the Middle level.

We, at BTSC, believe that education is not only about the books, curriculum, and assessments therefore, we teach our students through hands-on activities too so the education does not remain abstract for them.

Bahria town School & College Lahore is registered with Lahore Board and offers the approved curriculum of Punjab Text Book Board while our Karachi campus offers SSC from Aga Khan Examination Board. Students opting for Matriculation/SSC are required to take five Compulsory subjects and three elective subjects, in a choice of two available subject combinations. Students sit for the Part 1 External Board Exam in Grade IX and appear for the Part 2 External Board Exams in Grade X, for all the eight subjects.

To prepare our students for External Exams, we conduct continuous monthly assessments/tests, throughout the session.

THE CIE CURRICULUM

The school uses curriculum recommended by University of Cambridge. The Cambridge international curriculum sets a global standard for education, and is recognized by universities and employers worldwide. The curriculum is flexible, challenging and inspiring, culturally sensitive yet international in approach. Cambridge students develop an informed curiosity and a lasting passion for learning. They also gain the essential skills they need for success at university and in their future careers. Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) is the world's largest provider of academic qualification certification for 14 to 19-year-olds. The O and A Level certification is recognized worldwide by 160 countries and makes the student eligible for admission to colleges and universities in Pakistan and abroad.

EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT

Students, after passing their 8th Grade Examination are given an orientation for External Exam programs, introducing O level with an extensive exploratory program for 5 months as Pre-O-levels i.e. prior to commencing their studies in August at Grade 9-O. The advisory period is used for guidance and assessment of the O-Level students. At the end of Class X, students have the option to appear in University of Cambridge O-Level examination, for selected subjects.

Students opting for O-Levels are required to take a minimum of 8 subjects including compulsory subjects. A range of subjects, catering for a variety of academic needs and interests, are offered. These include the five compulsory and three optional subjects leading to Ordinary Level ('O' level) certification.



ICT LABS

STEAM LABS

BTSC follows a curriculum that fulfils the needs for ICT education in 21st century. All campuses have designated labs for students of different grades, designed and equipped according to their requirements.

BTSC follows safe internet usage policy. Being a responsible digital citizen is part of BTSC's ethos. Students working in labs are always under surveillance of instructors and network administrators and are expected to work under the stated IT policy.

STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) education is an emerging methodology where all subjects are taught in relation to each another. BTSC has adopted this method of teaching and has set up STEAM Labs, across all campuses. Students work on a series of well-structured projects which gives them a hands-on minds-on experience for their learning. This is done with the help of world-famous science kits made by Cornelsen Experimenta©, Germany.

Robotics is one of the most exciting feature of STEAM Laboratories. A progressive and comprehensive curriculum is designed to give the students a sound Robotics education, through their primary and middle levels. Lego Education© kits along with high tech tablet and laptop computers are provided to teach how real robots are made to perform their tasks. This program also develops collaborative problem solving and critical thinking skills amongst the students.

SCIENCE LABS

We believe it is imperative to have well equipped, state of the art science laboratories for our students to experience and apply the scientific knowledge learnt in the classroom. We offer separate laboratories for Biology, Physics and Chemistry. These laboratories also facilitate the preparation of Matric and Intermediate practical examinations. Students' safety is ensured while they work in the labs with protective gear and supervision.





FOOD & NUTRITION LABS



The Food and Nutrition program at BTSC is designed to encourage students to learn about healthy food choices and nutrition. The students are taught the science of nutrition, malnutrition, causes of different diseases by excessive or low consumption of different food components. The nutrition labs provide commercial style kitchens for students to experience all types of food processing that includes preparation, cutting, cooking, baking etc. Special focus is given to teach the students about table laying and food presentation skills.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

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REGISTRATION

To register their child with BTSC, the Parents may visit the school admission office from Monday to Saturday any time between 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The parents also have the option of registering their child through the school website. For registration at School Admission office, the following documents are required to complete the registration process.

- Copy of Father's /Guardian's NIC
- Basic information for the registration and student's B-Form/ NICOP/FRC copy

While applying for online registration, the Parents are required to fill in all the requisite information on the registration form: Select the campus and class to be enrolled, provide details about previous school and basic information regarding Parents/ Guardians.

The Parent can pay the registration fee once they have received the voucher from the respective admission personnel via email or on campus visit. Once a child has been registered, the admission process will begin.

Test and Evaluation

Admission is given strictly on merit-based evaluation of the student's academic performance. After getting registered, the student will be required to sit for an Admission Test based on the three subjects namely English, Urdu and Mathematics. Foreign applicants are exempted from Urdu at Jr and Middle levels. Admission is granted after the admission test and an interview with the Vice Principal has been successfully concluded.

For O-levels/Matric admissions, the opted subjects will also be tested. The students seeking admission in Intermediate / A levels/B.A/B.Com will not be required to take any written test. Their admission will depend on their O levels / Matric results and the interview.
